GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JULY, 1935.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that Canada produced 91,484 tons of gypsum in July as compared with 75,525 tons in June and 65,567 tons in July, 1934. Production during the first seven months of 1935 totalled 263,081 tons or17.4per cent above the tonnage produced in the corresponding period of 1934.

Customs' records show that exports of crude gypsum from Canada in July amounted to 59,554 tons; in June, 50,477 tons were exported. Plaster of Paris exports in July were recorded at 47 tons as against 89 tons in June.

Eight tons of ground gypsum worth \$288 and 257 tons of plaster of Paris at \$3,025 were imported into Canada in July. The corresponding figures for June were 21 tons valued at 4468 and 90 tons worth \$1,718.
