GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA ... AUGUST, 1935.

Gypsum production in Canada amounted to 81.228 tons in August, during the preceding month 91.484 tons were produced while in August, a year ago, the output was 59.517 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the eight months ending August, Canada produced 344.309 tons of gypsum as compared with 283,599 tons in the corresponding period of 1934.

Exports of crude gypsum from Canada in August were recorded at 71,207 tons or 19.6% above the tonnage exported in the preceding month. Plaster of Paris exports rose to 114 tons from the July total of 147 tons.

Receipts of ground gypsum during August amounted to 47 tons worth \$1,948, as against 8 tons at \$288, imported in July. Imports of plaster of Paris advanced to 467 tons appraised at \$6,749, from the July importations of 257 tons at \$3.025.
