GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - SEPTEMBER, 1935.

The Canadian production of gypsum in September was recorded at 48,058 tons as compared with 81,228 tons in the preceding month and 44,419 tons in September, 1934, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the nine months ending September totalled 392,367 tons or an increase of 19.6 per, cent over the tonnage produced in the corresponding months of 1934.

Customs' records show that Canada exported 63,394 tons of crude gypsum in September; during August 71,207 tons were exported. Exports of plaster of Paris in September declined to 43 tons from the August total of 114 tons.

Twenty-one tons of ground gypsum valued at \$379 were imported into Uanada in September as against 47 tons at \$1,948 imported in August. Plaster of Paris importations in September amounted to 69 tons worth \$1,371; in the previous month 467 tons with a value of \$6,749 were imported.
