## MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - NOVEMBER, 1936.

Gypsum production in Canada during November smounted to 75,661 tons; in October, 157,490 tons were produced, while in November, 1935, the output was 67,885 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the eleven months ending November totalled 801,289 tons as against 520,597 tons in the corresponding period of 1935.

Canada exported 97,005 tons of crude gypsum in November; during the preceding month 89,650 tons were exported. Exports of plaster of Paris from Canada in November rose to 133 tons from the October total of 45 tons.

Receipts of ground gypsum during November were recorded at 69 tons worth \$2,331 as compared with 63 tons at \$1,212 imported in October. Plaster of Paris imports advanced to 223 tons appraised at \$2,505 from the October importations of 72 tons at \$1,599.
