MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - June. 1936.

The Canadian production of gypsum in June amounted to 136,537 tons, as compared with 76,634 tons produced in May, and 75,707 tons in June, 1935, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the six months ending June, 266,271 tons of gypsum were produced in Canada; in the corresponding period of a year ago, 172,010 tons were produced.

Customs' records show that 64,093 tons of crude gypsum were exported from Canada in June; in the preceding month 31,425 tons were exported. Exports of plaster of Paris from Canada rose to 69 tons from the May total of 57 tons.

Ground gypsum imports into Canada in June amounted to 103 tons, worth \$2,844, making a total of 169 tons, valued at \$5,336 for the first six months of 1930. Receipt of plaster of Paris during June were recorded at 91 tons, at \$2,346 as against 79 tons with a valuation of \$1,519 in May.
