## MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANTADA - MARCH, 1937.

The Canadian aroduction of gypsum during March advanced to 23,352 tons from the February total of 4,827 tons and the March, 1936, output of 5,329 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first quarter of the current year 36,652 tons of gypsum were produced in Canada as compared with 13,093 tons, a ycar ago.

Exports of crude gypsum from Canada in March were recorded at 15,850 tons; in the preceding month 3,000 tons were exported. Plaster of Paris exportations from Canada advanced to 161 tons from the February total of 32 tons.

Plaster of Paris imports into Canada in March amounted to 96 tons worth $\$ 2,108$; in February, 60 tons at $\$ 1,525$ were imported. Reccipts during the first three months of 1937 totalled 214 tons valued at $\$ 5,196$.
