## MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA- JULY, 1937.

Gypsum production in Canada during July advanced to 125,762 tons from the preceding month's total of 161,978 tons and the July, 1936, output of 132,461 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the seven months ending July totalled 503,670 tons as compared with 371,956 tons, a year ago.

Exports of crude gypsum from Canada in July were recorded at 129,958 tons in June, 92,148 tons were exported. Plaster of Paris exportations rose to 125 tons Prom the preceding month's total of 44 tons.

Ground gypsum imports amounted to 8 tons worth 160 ; in June, 6 tons at. 4189 were imported. Plaster of Paris receipts declined to lu 7 tons valued at 2,655 from the June total of 214 tons worth 3,575 .
