MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PROJUCTION IN CANADA - AUGUST, 1937.

The Canadian production of gypsum in August amounted to 116,754 tons as compared with 125,762 tons in July and 81,896 tons in August, 1936, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the eight months ending August, 620,424 tons were produced or 36.7 per cent above the total for the corresponding period of 1936.

Crude gypsum exports were recorded at 107,623 tons; in July, 129,998 tons were exported. Exports of crude gypsum during the first eight months of this year aggregated 462,633 tons and of plaster of Paris, 764 tons.

Imports of ground gypsum amounted to 13 tons worth \$225 in August as against 8 tons at \$160 in July. Receipts of plaster of Paris in August totalled 116 tons valued at \$2,377; in the preceding month, 107 tons at \$2,655 were imported.
