MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA- SEPTEMBER, 1937.

Gypsum production in Canada during September advanced to 146,582 tons from the preceding month's total of 116,754 tons and the September, 1936 output of 87,510 tons according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first nine months of the current year, 767,006 tons were produced as compared with 541,362 tons a year ago.

Exports of crude gypsum from Canada in September were recorded at 99,160 tons; in August 107,623 tons were exported. Customs' records show that 561,793 tons of crude gypsum were exported during the nine months ending September, 1937; plaster of Paris exports during the same period totalled 836 tons.

Ground gypsum imports in September amounted to 58 tons worth \$2,464 as against 13 tons at \$225. <sup>in August</sup> Plaster of Paris importations declined to 53 tons appraised at \$1,691 from the August total of 116 tons at \$2,377.
