## MOTTHLY REPORT

## GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JANUARY, 1938.

Gypsum production in Canada during January was recorded at 6,159 tons; in the preceding month, 71,272 tons were produced while in January, 1937, the output was 8,473 tons according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Exports of crude gypsum in January totalled 59,893 tons compared with 55,080 tons in December. Plaster of Paris exports from Canada declined to 135 tons in January from the December total of 155 tons.

Eight tons of ground gypsum worth \$193 were imported into Canada in January; during December 48 tons at \$1,949 were imported. Plaster of Paris receipts during the month were recorded at 32 tons with a valuation of \$1,114 compared with the December total of 93 tons at \$1,542.
