GYPSUA PRODUCTTON IN CIMADA - DECHIBER, 1938.

The Canadian production of gypsum amounted to 82,452 tons in December compared with 97,388 tons in November and 71,339 tons in December, 1987, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Exports of crude EJpsum during the month totelled 25,921 tons, thus making the total quantity exported during the year, 810,109 tons. Plaster of Paris exportations in December arounted to 79 tons while the total for the year was 1,458 tons. Gypsum production during the calender yeer e.ggregated $1,014,205$ tons; in the nreceding year, $1,017,187$ tons were produced.

Imports of ground gypsum in December declined to 5 tons worth $\$ 100$ from the November total of 88 tons at $\$ 3,321$. Foccints of flaster of Paris were 56.7 fer cent lower at 114 tons; the year's totol was l, 325 tons. The United Stetes suppliod 63.5 per cent of the tonnage of plaster of Paris brought into Canada; Germany, 24.5 per cent; Belgium, 5.5 per cent, and Creat Britain, 0.5 per cent.
