MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - FEBRUARY, 1938.

Historice Line Cost The Canadian production of gypsum in February amounted to 5,517 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In January, 6,159 tons were produced while in February, 1937, the production totalled 4,327 tons.

No crude gypsum was exported from Canada in February; in the preceding month, 69,893 tons were exported. Plaster of Paris exports amounted to 100 tons compared with 135 tons in January.

Ground gypsum importations in February rose to 20 tons worth (232 from the January total of 8 tons at \$193. Receipts of plaster of Paris totalled 105 tons valued at \$3,375; in January, 32 tons at \$1,114 were imported.
