 proceling month's output of 137,554 tons and the August, 1937, total of 116,598 tons, acoording to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Crude gypsum exports from Canade in August amounted to 129,070 tons compared with 131,780 tons in July. Exports of plaster of Paris rose to 152 tons from the provious month's total of 34 tons. Production of gypsum during the first eight months of 1938 aggregated 619,009 tons; in the corresponding period of 1937 the output was 619,688 tons.

Imports of ground gypsum into Canada in Aug!st amounted to 30 tons worth 582 ; in July, 10 tons at 172 were imported. Plaster of Paris importations declined to 76 tons appraised at $\$ 1,300$ from the July total of 123 tons at 2,651 .
