dioice like Coot The Canadian production of gypsum during August rose to 144,261 tons from the preceding month's output of 137,554 tons and the August, 1937, total of 116,598 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Crude gypsum exports from Canada in August amounted to 129,070 tons compared with 131,780 tons in July. Exports of plaster of Paris rose to 152 tons from the previous month's total of 34 tons. Production of gypsum during the first eight months of 1938 aggregated 619,009 tons; in the corresponding period of 1937 the output was 619,688 tons.

Imports of ground gypsum into Canada in August amounted to 30 tons worth \$582; in July, 10 tons at 172 were imported. Plaster of Paris importations declined to 76 tons appraised at \$1,300 from the July total of 123 tons at \$2,651.
