MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - SEPTEMBER, 1938.

Gypsum production in Canada during September totalled 119,221 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In August, 144,261 tons were produced while in September, 1937, the output amounted to 146,598 tons. Exports of crude gypsum from Canada during the month under review declined to 91,836 tons from the August total of 129,070 tons. Plaster of Paris exportations were 82.2 per cent lower at 27 tons in September. During the first nine months of the current year, 738,230 tons of gypsum were produced compared with 756,285 tons in the corresponding months of 1937.

Imports of plaster of Paris into Canada in September totalled 189 tons worth \$2,295; in the preceding month, 76 tons valued at \$1,300 were imported. The September receipts were made up of 108 tons from the United States, 55 tons from Belgium, 25 tons from Germany, and 1 ton from Great Britain.
