GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - FEBRUARY,

historical file Copy The Canadian production of gypsum in February amounted to 5,331 tons compared with 18,463 tons in the preceding month and 5,517 tons in February, 1938, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the first two months of 1939 totalled 23,794 tons; a year ago, 11,676 tons were produced.

No crude gypsum was exported from Canada in February; during the preceding month, 90,683 tons were exported. One hundred and twenty-six tons of plaster of Paris were exported during the month compared with 147 tons in January.

Imports of ground gypsum amounted to 50 tons worth \$683; in January, 26 tons at #383 were imported. Plaster of Paris importations declined to 47 tons appraised at \$1,055 from the preceding month's total of 88 tons at \$2,820.
