(The Canadian output of gypsum in April amounted to 67,617 tons compared with 12,997 tons in the precedjng month and 49,570 tons in April, 1933, accurding to a statement just issued by the Dominion Pureau of Statistics at ottawa. Production during the firgt four months of the current year agejregrted 104,398 tons or 53.2 per cent above the tonnige produced a your ago.

Crude gypsum exports from Canada in April were recorded at 24,120 tons; in March, 6,000 tons were exported. Exports of plaster of Puris declined to 138 tons from tre previous month'is total of 194 tons.

Ton tons of ground gypsum velued at $\$ 236$ mere imported into Canada in April as acainst 91 tone at $\$ 2,577$ imported in March. Plaster of Paris importations amounted to 135 tons appraised at $\$ 3,137$; in the precsding month, 133 tons at $\$ 2,451$ ware imported.
