## MONTHLY REPORT

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - APRIL, 1939.

The Canadian output of gypsum in April amounted to 67,617 tons compared with 12,987 tons in the preceding month and 49,579 tons in April, 1938, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the first four months of the current year aggregated 104,398 tons or 53.2 per cent above the tonnage produced a year ago.

Crude gypsum exports from Canada in April were recorded at 24,120 tons; in March, 6,000 tons were exported. Exports of plaster of Paris declined to 138 tons from the previous month's total of 194 tons.

Ten tons of ground gypsum valued at \$236 were imported into Canada in April as against 91 tons at \$2,577 imported in March. Plaster of Paris importations amounted to 135 tons appraised at \$3,137; in the preceding month, 133 tons at \$2,451 were imported.
