## MONTHLY REPORT

## QYPSLV FROBUCTTON IN CANADA = MAY, 1939.

(\%) Gypsum production in Canada during May rose to 116,696 tons from the precding month's total of 67,617 tions and the May, 1938, output of 110,515 tons, accorcing to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the five months ending May; production totalled 22l,094 tons compared with 178,673 tons, a year ago.

Exports of crude gypsum from Canada in May amounted to 71,645 tons; in April, 24,120 tons were exported. Plaster of Paris exportations declined to 102 tons from the April total of 138 tons.

Customs' records show that 58 tons of ground gypsum morth $\$ 826$ were imported as against 10 tons at $\$ 236$ imported in April. Imports of plaster of Paris advanced to 173 tons appraised at $\$ 2,234$ from the previous month's receipts of 135 tons at $\$ 3,137$.
