Gypsum production in Canada during September was recorded at 196,321 tons compared with 191,637 tons in the previous month and 118,550 tons in September, 1938 according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at ottawa. During the first nine months of the current year, 907,130 tons were produced; in the corresponding period, a year ago, the output was 734,289 tons.

Crude gypsum exports from Canada in September rose to 238,960 tons from the August total of 93,660 tons. One hundred and sixty-three tons of plaster of Paris were exported during the month as against 72 tons in Airgust.

Ground gypsum importations in September amounted to 51 tons at $\$ 2,213$, in August, 7 tons at $\$ 145$ were imported. Receipts of plaster of Puris declined to 193 tons valued at $\$ 3,219$ from the preceding month's total of 254 tons worth $\$ 3,154$.
