The following table shows the composition of the Gross National Product at market prices for the years 1967 to 1972. The figures are in billions of dollars.

The table is divided into three main sections: Private Sector, Government Sector, and Exports and Imports. The Private Sector is further divided into Manufacturing, Wholesale and Retail Trade, and Services. The Government Sector is divided into Federal, Provincial, and Municipal. Exports and Imports are shown as a percentage of the total GNP.
