COAL

Canada's coal supply (computed on the basis of production plus imports less exports) in August was 2,154,576 tons, a 21.0 per cent decline from the August average for the past five years of 2,726,611 tons. The August coal supply included 317,896 tons of anthracite coal, 1,688,858 tons of bituminous coal, 31,105 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 116,717 tons of lignite coal.

C O K E

Production of coke in Canada during August showed an increase for the third month in succession when it amounted to 150,283 tons. This output was 4 per cent over the 144,812 tons of July which in turn was 7 per cent greater than the 135,546 tons of June. Each of the producing areas reported an increase over July. In the eastern provinces the tonnage rose to 40,221 tons from 36,625 tons; in Ontario the output advanced to 96,857 tons from 94,998 tons, and in the western provinces to 13,205 tons from 13,189 tons.

August totals included 9,863 tons of breeze of which 2,924 tons were made in the east, 6,378 tons in Ontario, and 561 tons in the west. Sales of breeze totalled 4,884 tons of which 3,948 tons were sold by Ontario producers.

During the month 49,729 tons of Canadian coal and 155,206 tons of imported coal were carbonized in Canada to make 150,283 tons of coke. For the first eight months of this year the output of coke aggregated 1,103,905 tons as compared with 1,089,757 tons during the corresponding period of 1932.
