COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA - NOVEMBER, 1935.

COAL

The Canadian production of coal in November reached a total of 1,601,464 tons as compared with 1,429,128 tons in November, 1934, and the five-year average for the month of 1,366,261 tons. Output during November, 1935, included 885,287 tons of bituminous coal, 80,156 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 636,021 tons of lignite coal.

Alberta operators reported an output of 790,810 tons made up of 220,046 tons of bituminous coal, 80,156 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 490,608 tons of lignite coal. In November, 1934, the production totalled 552,113 tons consisting of 164,162 tons of bituminous coal, 63,350 tons of sub-bituminous coal, and 324,601 tons of lignite coal. A decline of 15.8 per cent was recorded in Nova Scotia's production in November; the month's output was 503,681 tons as against 597,990 tons in the corresponding month of 1934. Saskatchewan's production advanced to 144,603 tons from the November, 1934, total of 115,787 tons. Production in British Columbia during November was at approximately the same level as was reported a year ago and totalled 131,418 tons. New Brunswick mined 30,142 tons as compared with 30,664 tons in November, 1934.

Imports of coal into Canada in November amounted to 1,360,058 tons; during the corresponding month of the previous year 1,666,171 tons were imported. The 1930-1934 average for the month was 1,516,302 tons. Importations of anthracite coal in November consisted of 158,283 tons from Great Britain, 80,511 tons from the United States, 31,773 tons from Germany, 25,407 tons from French Indo-China, and 7,800 tons from Belgium. Receipts of bituminous coal were made up of 1,024,777 tons from the United States, 30,692 tons from Great Britain, 30 tons from Norway and 1 ton from Alaska. Seven hundred and eighty-four tons of lignite coal were imported from the United States during the month.

The November exports of Canadian coal advanced to 45,981 tons from the November, 1934, total of 29,634 tons and the five-year average for the month of 34.642 tons.

Canada's coal supply in November (computed on the basis of production plus imports less exports) totalled 2,915,541 tons as against 3,065,665 tons made available a year ago and 2,817,921 tons, the November 1930-1934 average.

COKE

The production of 205,815 tons of coke in Canada during November marked a slight improvement over the 205,213 tons of the previous month which in turn was the highest output reported for any month since December, 1930. The corresponding total for November of a year ago was 198,861 tons.

Data for the month under review, when compared with the figures for October, show that output in Ontario advanced to 123,136 tons from 121,113 tons and in the western provinces to 16,475 tons from 16,310 tons, while in the eastern provinces it fell off to 66,204 tons from 67,790 tons. The month's output included 12,854 tons of breeze of which 7,271 tons were sold for domestic or other uses. In the east the production of breeze amounted to 6,296 tons and 3,563 tons were sold; in Ontario 5,813 tons were made and 993 tons sold. The balance of the breeze was made in the western provinces.

For the eleven months ending November, 1935, the total production of coke in Canada was 2,066,070 tons as compared with corresponding totals for the same periods of other years of 2,069,952 in 1934, 1,606,360 in 1933 and 1,490,484 in 1932.
