## MONTHLY REPORT

## COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA - APRIL, 1936.

Coal production in Canada during April reached a total of 936,441 tons; in the preceding month 1,030,325 tons were produced and in April, 1935, the output was 892,074 tons. The average output for April during the past five years was 803,201 tons. Production during the month under review consisted of 746,514 tons of bituminous coal, 33,989 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 155,938 tons of lignite coal.

Nova Scotia producers reported an output of 424,711 tons in April as compared with 369,143 tons a year ago. Alberta's output amounted to 309,294 tons made up of 165,765 tons of bituminous coal, 33,989 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 109,540 tons of lignite coal. In April, 1935, the Alberta production totalled 342,844 tons and consisted of 187,816 tons of bituminous coal, 35,116 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 119,912 tons of lignite coal. The British Columbia output in April rose 13.4 per cent to 126,732 tons from the tonnage mined in the corresponding month of 1935. An advance of 2.8 per cent was recorded in Saskatchewan's production when 46,398 tons were produced as against 45,149 tons a year ago. New Brunswick mines produced 29,306 tons or 26.5 per cent above the April, 1935, total.

Imports of coal into Canada in April declined 24.4 per cent to 492,870 tons from the tonnage imported in April a year ago and 5.8 per cent from the average for the month during the period 1931 - 1935. The Canadian importations of anthracite coal in April included 70,646 tons from Great Britain, 58,256 tons from the United States and 130 tons from Germany. Bituminous coal receipts were made up of 346,736 tons from the United States and 16,880 tons from Great Britain. Lignite coal imports amounted to 222 tons.

Exports of Canadian coal increased 14.7 per cent to 14,765 tons from the April, 1935, total of 12,868 tons. The five-year average for the month was 10,874 tons.

Canada's coal supply in April (computed on a basis of production plus imports less exports) amounted to 1,414,546 tons as compared with the April, 1931 - 1935 average of 1,315,488 tons.

Production of coke from beehive and by-product ovens and from gas retorts totalled 190,041 tons during the month of April. This tonnage was 6 per cent below the March total of 202,411 tons but it was 6 per cent above the 180,243 tons for April of last year.

The figures for April of this year include 11,566 tons of breeze of which 6,137 tons were sold. In the eastern provinces 5,849 tons were produced and 4,216 tons were sold; in Ontario 5,043 tons were made and 875 tons sold, while in the western provinces 674 tons were made and 1,046 tons were sold.
