MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA - JULY, 1936.

Canadian mines produced 1,050,007 tons of coal in July as compared with 1,035,241 tons in June and 981,080 tons in July, 1935. The July, 1931-1935, average output was 826,260 tons. During the month under review the Canadian output included 958,147 tons of bituminous coal, 15,608 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 76,252 tons of lignite coal

Nova Scotia's production rose 10.7 per cent in July to 646,400 tons from the July, 1935, total of 583,832 tons. The output from Alberta mines totalled 242,863 tons and included 177,394 tons of bituminous coal, 15,608 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 49,861 tons of lignite coal. In July, a year ago, Alberta produced 182,863 tons of bituminous coal, 21,365 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 50,319 tons of lignite coal. British Columbia's output amounted to 112,817 tons as compared with 96,467 tons produced in July, 1935. Saskatchewan operators reported an output of 26,391 tons or 10.2 per cent above the total for the corresponding month of 1935. New Brunswick's production was slightly lower at 21,536 tons.

Canada imported 1,416,455 tons of coal in July as against 1,430,483 tons, a year ago. Imports of anthracite coal during the month under review were made up of 179,217 tons from Great Britain, 105,951 tons from the United States, 74,813 tons from Germany and 7,392 tons from Belgium. Receipts of bituminous coal included 1,028,548 tons from the United States, 18,972 tons from Great Britain, 1,324 tons from Germany and minor tonnages from Denmark, Norway, the Netherlands, Sweden and Newfoundland.

Exports of coal from Canada in July were recorded at 30,182 tons; in the corresponding month of 1935 the total was 41,961 tons.

Coal made available for consumption in Canada in July was computed at 2,436,280 tons as compared with 2,369,602 tons, a year ago.

Production of coke in Canada during July amounted to 193,264 tons, a decline of 3 per cent from the 198,953 tons of June and an improvement of 10 per cent over the 176,291 tons made in July of a year ago.

Output for the month under review included 11,595 tons of breeze of which 4,491 tons were sold. In the eastern provinces 5,214 tons of breeze were produced and 3,168 tons sold, in Ontario 5,622 tons were made and 1,027 tons sold, while in the western provinces, 759 tons were made and 296 tons sold.
