

## MONTHLY REPORT

## COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA - OCTOBEA, 1937.

The Canadian production of coal during October totalled 1,694,210 tons; in the preceding month $1,402,496$ tons were produced while in October, 1936 the output was $1,808,166$ tons. The average output for October during the past five years was $1,555,4 \sim 9$ tons. Bituminous coal production in October amounted to $1,064,084$ tons, sub-bituminous coal, 61,165 tons and lignite coal, 568,961 tons.

Alberta operators reported an output of 690,760 tons in October, made up of 212,628 tons of bituminous coal, 61,165 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 416,967 tons of lignite coal. During October, a year ago, 243,881 tons of bituminous coal, 67,867 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 481,179 tons of lipnite coal were mined. Nova Scotia produced 688,985 tons as compared with 690,343 tons, a year ago. An increase of 11.5 percent was recordod in British Columbia's output when 144,392 tons were produced as against 129,532 tons in October, 1936. Saskatchewan's production declined 6 per cent to 151,994 tons from the tonnage produced a year ago. Owing to a strike in several of the coal mines in New Brunswick production during the month declined to 18,079 tons from the total of 32,856 tons for October, 1936.

Canada imported $1,837,501$ tons of coal in October; during the corresponding month, a year ago, 1,653,744 tons were imported while the average for the month during the period ly32-1936 was 1,409,067 tons. Receipts of anthracite coal amounted to 408,238 tons and included 187,528 tons from the United States, 188,528 tons from Great britain, 29,874 tons from Germany and 22,308 tons from Russia。 Importations of tituminous coal in October from the United States totalled, 1,417,884 tons, from Germany 8,041 tons, from Great Britain, 3,013 tons and from Norway, 40 tons. Lignite coal imports from the United States totalled 285 tons.

Exports of Canadian coal amounted to 22,997 tons as compared with 36,522 tons a year ago and 34,007 tons, the 1932-1936 average for October.

Canada's coal supply during the month (computed on the basis of production plus imports less exports) totalled 3,498,714 tons; in October, 1936, the available supply was $3,405,388$ tons.

Production of coke in Canada totalled 218,077 tons during October compared with 208,086 tons made in the previous month and 212,344 tons in October，1936。 During the first ten months of this year， 965,895 tons of Canadian coal and $2,001,281$ tons of imported coal were carbonized to produce 2，131，203 tons of coke．Output figures for the corresponding periods of 1936 and 1935 amounted to $1,986,590$ tons and $1,860,255$ tons，respectively．

Included in Octoker Aigures were 12，817 tons of breeze of which 3，332 tons were sold．Breeze production by areas was asfollows－Eastern provinces，6，223 tons； Ontario，5，180 tons，and the Western Provinces，1，414 tons．
