MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA - MARCH, 1937.

Coal production in Canada during March totalled 1,090,931 tons; in February, 1,292,002 tons were produced. The average output for the month during the past five years was 994,909 tons. Production during March, 1937 included 836,698 tons of bituminous coal, 34,035 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 220,198 tons of lignite coal.

Nova Scotia operators reported an output of 452,727 tons of coal in March as against 425,146 tons, a year ago. Alberta mines produced 373,496 tons, made up of 200,112 tons of bituminous coal, 34,035 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 139,349 tons of lignite coal. During March, 1936, Alberta's output included 178,726 tons of bituminous coal, 47,779 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 155,374 tons of lignite coal. An advance of 15.7 per cent was recorded in Saskatchewan's production; the month's total was 80,849 tons and the March, 1936 total, 69,906 tons. British Columbia mines produced 143,782 tons; this represented an increase of 14.2 per cent over the tonnage mined, a year ago. New Brunswick's output rose to 40,077 tons from the March, 1936 total of 24,945 tons.

Imports of coal into Canada in March amounted to 623,071 tons; in the corresponding month of 1936 imports totalled 506,260 tons. The March 1932-1936 average was 589,914 tons. Importations of anthracite coal during March consisted of 150,554 tons from the United States, 13,640 tons from Great Britain and 2,148 tons from Germany. Bituminous coal receipts were recorded at 456,682 tons; the United States accounted for 99.3 per cent of these imports; Great Britain, 0.5 per cent and Germany, 0.2 per cent. Forty-seven tons of lignite coal were imported into Canada from the United States during March.

Exports of Canadian coal during the month under review were at approximately the same level as a year ago and amounted to 40,848 tons. Exports averaged 26,748 tons in March during the past five years.

Coal made available for consumption in Canada during March (computed on the basis of production plus imports less exports) totalled 1,673,154 tons as compared with the five-year average for the month of 1,558,075 tons.

COKE

Coke production totalled 221,039 tons in March compared with 198,277 tons in the previous month and 202,411 tons in March, 1936. The daily rate of output in March was 7,335 tons, an increase of 3.5 per cent over the daily average of 7,081 tons in February.

During March, 103,586 tons of Canadian coal and 203,688 tons of imported coal were carbonized to produce 221,039 tons of coke, making a total output for the first three months of this year of 636,926 tons. The corresponding total for the first quarter of a year ago amounted to 612,022 tons.

Included in the March production figures were 14,720 tons of breeze of which 6,371 tons were sold. In the eastern provinces 7,652 tons of breeze were made and 4,173 tons sold; in Ontario the output was 5,920 tons with sales of 767 tons, and in the western provinces 1,148 tons were produced and 1,431 tons sold.
