## MONTHLY REPORT

## COAL ATD COKE STATISTICS FOR CATADA - DECFABER, 1939

Canadian coal mines produced $1,457,825$ tons of coal in December; a year ago $1,350,386$ tons were produced whilc the five-year average for the month was $1,407,405$ tons. Bituminous coal output in December amounted to $1,059,055$ tons, sub-bituminous coal, 53,166 tons and lignite coal, 345,604 tons.

Production from Nova Scotia mines totalled 625,723 tons compared with 428, 200 tons-a year ago. Operators in Alberta mined 536,795 tons, made up of 249,559 tons of bituminous coal, 53,166 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 234,070 tons of lignite coal. In December, 1938, Alverta produced 218,576 tons of bituminous coal, 57,692 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 321,449 tons of lignite coal. A 9.3 per cent increase was recorded in British Columbia's production; during tie month under review 145,630 tons were mined as against 133,210 tons in December, 1938. Saskatchewan's output declined 26.3 per cent to 111,534 tons. New Brunswlek mined 38,143 tons; in December, a year ago, 38,968 tons were produced.

The Canadian imports of coal in December rose to $1,157,869$ tons from the December, 1938 total of 848,252 tons and the 1934-1938 average for the montin of 868,253 tons. Importations of antiracite coal during the month under review consisted of 115,860 tons from the United States, 33,775 tons from Great Britain and 3,476 tons from Germany. Bituminous coal imports included 1,001,198 tons from the Inited States and 3,128 tons from Great Britain. Receipts of lignite coal from the Inited states amounted to 432 tons in December.

Canadian coal exported in December advanced to 41,400 tons from the Iecember, 1938 total of 28,740 tons. The December 1934-1938 average was 41,651 tons.

The Canadian coal supply in December (computed on the basis of production plus imports less exports) was 2,574,294 tons or 18.6 per cent above the tonnage made available for use a year ago.

During the calendar year 1939, Canada produced $15,460,897$ tons of coal, imported $13,834,816$ tons and exported 376,203 tons. In 1938, the Canadian output was $14,294,718$ tons; imports totalled $13,461,614$ tons and exports amounted to 353,181 tons.

COKE - DECEBBER 1939
Coke production during December totalled 243,123 tons, this being the preatest tonnage reported for any month since the Bureąu conmenced collecting monthly data in 1926. This month's output was 6 per cent higher than the November figure of 229,216 tons and 28 per cent above the corresponding total of 189,602 tons for December of a year ago.

During the calendar year 1939 the charges to coke ovens and gas retorts included 1,104,371 tons of Canadian coal and 2,207,707 tons of imported coal, a total of $3,312,078$ tons from thich 2,388,027 tons of coke were produced. In 1933 the coke output amounted to $2,352,003$ tons, in 1937 it was $2,570,385$ tons, and in 1936 it was 2,104,793 tons.
