

## MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISIICS FOR CANADA = FEBRUARY. 1939.

Canada produced 1,290,383 tons of coal in February compáred with 1,173,360 tons in the preceding month and 1,404,730 tons in Fcbruary, 1938. The Canadian output during February, 1934-1938, has averaged 1,212,325 tons. Bituminous coal production in February amounted to 773,174 tons; sub-bituminous coal, 50,150 tons, and lignite coal, 467,059 tons.

Production from Alberta mines in Febmary totalled 571, 218 tons, made up of 202, 208 tons of bituminous coal, 50,150 tons of sub-bituminous coal, and 318,960 tons of lignite coal. In February, 1938, Alberta produced 212,640 tons of bituminous coal, 61,105 tons of sub-bituminous coal, and 310,558 tons of lignite coal. Nova Scotia operators reported an output of 424,197 tons compared with 534,257 tons, a year ago. An increase of 20.3 per cent was recorded in Saskatchewan's production; the February total was 148,099 tons as against 123,097 tons à year ago. British Columbia's output declined 22.3 per cent to 104,984 tons from the February, 1938 , total of 135,047 tons. New Brunswick mines produced 41,885 tons or 51.9 per cent above their output a year ago.

The Canadian imports of coal amounted to 430,806 tons; this represented a decline of 2.3 per cent from the Febmary, 3938 , total and 9.2 per cent from the fiveyear average for the month. Anthracite coal importations in February consisted of 175,549 tons from the United States and 15,594 tons from Great Britain. Receipts of bituminous coal included 228,973 tons from the United States and 9,954 tons from Great Britain. Seven hundred and thirty-six tons of lignite coal were brought into Canada from the United States in February.

Exports of Canadian coal during February totalled 29,272 tans; a yoar ago, 32,667 tons were exported while during the past five years the average for the month was 30,553 tons.

Coal made available for consumption in Canada during February was computed at $1,691,317$ tons; cluring the corresponding month of 1938 the quantity made available was 1,815,021 tons.

## COKE - FEBRUARY, 1939.

Production of coke during February amounted to 176,537 tons, the daily rate of output being about 3 per cent less than in January when a total of 202,428 tons was produced. In February of a year ago, 199,340 tons were made.

During February, 75,357 tons of Canadian and 169,053 tons of imported coal were charged to coke ovens in Canada to make cumulative totals for the two months of this year of 158,616 tons of Canadian coal and 362,725 tons of imported coal. Coke output for the year to date totalled 378,965 tons, a decline of 10 per cent from the 423,248 tons made in the first two months of 1938.

The February output included 10,360 tons of breeze of which 4,194 tons were sold. In the eastern provinces, 4,711 tons of breeze were made and 2,533 tons sold in ontario, 4,709 tons were made and 799 tons sold, while in the west, 940 tons were made and 862 tons were sold.
