## MONTHLY REPORT

## COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA - AUGUST. 1939.

Coal production in Canada during August amounted to 1,238,171 tons, a year ago, 1,012,901 tons were produced while the five-year average for the month was 1,079,158 tons. During the month under review bituminous coal output totalled 1,072,362 tons, sub-bituminous coal, 24,274 tons and lignite coal, 141,535 tons.

Nova Scotia operators reported an output of 621,267 tons or 30.3 per cent above the total for August, 1938. Alberta mines produced 398,663 tons made up of 271,031 tons of bituminous coal, 24,274 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 103,358 tons of lignite coal. The August, 1938 Alberta output included 211,029 tons of bituminous coal, 15,616 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 124,831 tons of lignite coal. A 27.9 per cent increase was recorded in British Columbia's production in August; the month's output was 151,375 tons as against 118,351 tons, a year ago. Saskatchewan producers mined 38,177 tons; this represented a 14.6 per cent decline from the August, 1938 total. New Brunswick produced 28,689 tons; a year ago, 21,603 tons were produced.

Canada imported 1,628,296 tons of coal in August compared with 1,463,919 tons in the corresponding month of 1938 and 1,553,279 tons, the average for the month during the past five years. Anthracite coal imports during the month under review amounted to 342,840 tons, of which the United States contributed 144,173 tons, Great Britain, 134,191 tons and Germany 64,476 tons. Receipts of bituminous coal consisted of 1,276,820 tons from the United States and 8,556 tons from Great Britain.

Exports of Canadian coal declined to 25,042 tons from the August, 1938 total of 34,522 tons. The average quantity of coal exported in August during the past five years was 32,817 tons.

Coal made available for consumption in Canada in August was estimated at 2,841,425 tons; a year ago, 2,442,298 tons were made available for use.

## COKE - AUGUST, 1939.

Production of 190,723 tons of coke in Canada during August compares with 189,254 tons in July and 182,368 tons in the corresponding month of 1938. August when compared with the figures for July show that an advance in Ontario's output to 106,602 tons from 103,222 tons was largely offset by a drop in the eastern tonnage to 67,987 from 69,349 and in the western tonnage to 16,134 from 16,683.

During the month coke oven charges included 89,752 tons of Canadian coal and 174,564 tons of imported coal to make a total for the first eight months of this year of 694,661 tons of Canadian coal and 1,403,210 tons of imported coal. From these charges, amounting in all to 2,097,871 tons of coal, a total of 1,502,790 tons of coke were produced against 1,614,427 tons reported for the period ending August 31, 1938.

Included in this month's figures were 10,179 tons of breeze of which 3,431 tons were sold. Eastern provinces made 4,816 and sold 1,261 tons, Ontario made 4,520 tons and sold 1,544 tons, while western provinces produced 843 tons and sold 626 tons.
