MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA - APRIL, 1940

Coal production in Canada during April rose to 1,252,190 tons from the April, 1939 total of 912,327 tons. The April output during the past five years averaged 921,162 tons. Bituminous coal production in the month under review totalled 1,045,394 tons, sub-bituminous coal, 33,589 tons and lignite coal, 173,207 tons.

Nova Scotia's output amounted to 615,628 tons compared with 452,322 tons a year ago. Alberta produced 368,528 tons, made up of 228,246 tons of bituminous coal, 33,589 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 106,693 tons of lignite coal. In April, 1939 Alberta mined 169,364 tons of bituminous coal, 33,335 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 74,073 tons of lignite coal. Production from British Columbia mines advanced to 160,842 tons from the April, 1939 output of 117,839 tons. An increase was recorded in Saskatchewan's production; the month's total was 66,469 tons as against 29,114 tons a year ago. Operators in New Brunswick produced 40,678 tons or 12.1 per cent above the output in April, 1939.

Canada imported 595,297 tons of coal in April; a year ago, 264,520 tons were imported. During the period 1935-1939, the April importations averaged 570,129 tons. Receipts of anthracite coal in April totalled 127,995 tons and of bituminous coal 467,183 tons. Lignite coal imports from the United States amounted to 119 tons.

Exports of Canadian coal were recorded at 24,287 tons; a year ago, 14,945 tons were exported. During the first four months of 1940, Canada exported 152,931 tons; this represented a 32.3 per cent increase over the exportations in the corresponding period of 1939.

Coal made available for consumption in Canada in April amounted to 1,823,200 tons as against 1,161,902 tons made available a year ago.

COKE - APRIL, 1940

Production of coke in Canada totalled 237,110 tons in April compared with 239,290 tons in the previous month and 183,443 tons in April, 1939. Output in Ontario advanced to 132,158 tons from 129,901 tons in March, but production in the eastern provinces declined to 85,322 tons from 88,677 tons and in the western provinces to 19,630 tons from 20,712 tons.

This month's total included 16,305 tons of breeze of which 4,254 tons were sold. Eastern producers made 8,473 tons of breeze and sold 1,917 tons; works in Ontario made 6,757 tons and sold 1,993 tons, and producers in the Western provinces made 1,075 tons and sold 344 tons.

Producers' stocks of coke made from coal amounted to 203,220 tons at the end of April, including 58,600 tons in the east, 106,115 tons in Ontario and 38,505 tons in the west.

In addition to the coke reported above, there was a production in April of 3,233 tons of petroleum coke of which 2,793 tons were sold. Imports of petroleum coke totalled 5,124 tons in April. Stocks held by producers at the end of April amounted to 1,349 tons.
