## MONTILY RFPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISIICS FOR CAHADA - JUNE 1941

Coal production in Canada during June amounted to $1,157,727$ tons; in the preceding month, 1,198,255 tons were produced while in June, 1950 the output was $1,153,552$ tons. The average output for the month during the past five years was 1,064,643 tons.

Mines in Nova Scotia produced 439,675 tons compared with 622,802 tons, a jear ago. Nlberta's output totalled 411,824 tons, made up of 333,034 tons of bituminous cosl, 29,917 tons of sub-bituninous coal and 48,873 tons of lignite coal. During June, 1940 Alberta Kines produced 204,476 tons of bituminous coal, 35,639 tone of sub-bituminous coal and 48,599 tons of lignite coal. An increase of 4.7 per cent was recorded in the British Columbia output; the month's total was 155,317 tons as against 148,912 tons, a year ago. Saskatchewan produced 48,925 tons or 88.2 per cent above the production, a year ago. New Brunswick mined 41,386 tons or 1 per cent below the output in June, 1340.

Imports of coal into Canada during June rose 2.1 per cent to 2,465,664 tons from the tonnage imported, a year ago. The June, 1336-1940 imports averaged 1,801,382 tons.

Exports of Canadian coal amounted to 31,854 tons compared with 31,669 tons, a year ago, and the five year average for the month of 31,041 tons.

Canada's coal supply in June was computed at $3,591,537$ tons as against 3,541,991 tons, a year ago.

During this month 103, 75 tons or Canadian coal and 297,751 tons of imported cosl were cerbonized in Canadisn coke ovens makine a total for the first half of this year of 720,673 tons of Canadian conl and $1,231,41 \leq$ lons of imported ccal. Coke output for the year to date mas $1,5 \approx 4,162$ tons againel $1,453,203$ tons und $1,1 \times 2,81: 3$ tons reported for the first aix monthe of 1040 and 1250 respectively.

Producers' stociss of coke on June 20, 1941, amounted to 265,810 Łons, distributed across Canada as follows: 49,284 tons in the East, 185,974 tons in Ontario and 28,552 tons in the West.
