MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA - JUNE 1941

Coal production in Canada during June amounted to 1,157,727 tons; in the preceding month, 1,198,255 tons were produced while in June, 1940 the output was 1,159,552 tons. The average output for the month during the past five years was 1,064,643 tons.

Mines in Nova Scotia produced 499,675 tons compared with 622,802 tons, a year ago. Alberta's output totalled 411,824 tons, made up of 333,034 tons of bituminous coal, 29,917 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 48,873 tons of lignite coal. During June, 1940 Alberta Mines produced 234,476 tons of bituminous coal, 35,639 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 48,599 tons of lignite coal. An increase of 4.7 per cent was recorded in the British Columbia output; the month's total was 155,917 tons as against 148,912 tons, a year ago. Saskatchewan produced 48,925 tons or 88.2 per cent above the production, a year ago. New Brunswick mined 41,386 tons or 4 per cent below the output in June, 1940.

Imports of coal into Canada during June rose 2.1 per cent to 2,465,-664 tons from the tonnage imported, a year ago. The June, 1936-1940 imports averaged 1,801,582 tons.

Exports of Canadian coal amounted to 31,854 tons compared with 31,669 tons, a year ago, and the five year average for the month of 31,041 tons.

Canada's coal supply in June was computed at 3,591,537 tons as against 3,541,991 tons, a year ago.

COKE .- JUHE - 1941

Production of coke from coal in Canada amounted to 247,744 tons in June compared with 259,789 tons in the previous month and 249,232 tons in June of a year ago.

During this month 109,375 tons of Canadian coal and 237,751 tons of imported coal were carbonized in Canadian coke ovens making a total for the first half of this year of 720,673 tons of Canadian coal and 1,391,414 tons of imported coal. Coke output for the year to date was 1,534,462 tons against 1,459,309 tons and 1,122,813 tons reported for the first six months of 1940 and 1939 respectively.

Producers' stocks of coke on June 30, 1941, amounted to 263,810 tons, distributed across Canada as follows: 49,284 tons in the East, 185,974 tons in Ontario and 28,552 tons in the West.
