MONHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CAMADA－SEPTEMBER 1941

The Canadian output of coal in September amounted to $1,577,872$ tons compared with $1,366,196$ tons a year ago and the give year average for the month of $1,347,667$ tons

Production from Alberta mines totalled 746，792 tons，made up of 335，236 tons of bituminous coal，64，036 tons of sub bituminous coal and 347，520 tons of lignite coal．In soptember， 1940 Alberte produced 223,871 tons of bituminous coal， 49,248 tons of sub hituminous coal and 196，044 of lignite coal Nova Scotia pperators reported an output of 507,285 tons compared with 651,809 tons in September， 1940. An increase of 289 per cent was recorded in British Columbia＇s output；during the month under review， 176,693 tons were mined as against 137,063 tons，a year ago Saskatchewan produced 106,200 tons or 562 per cent above the September， 1940 total． New Brunswick＇s production amounted to 40,902 tons；in the corresponding month of 1940，thle province mined 40,361 tons．

Canada imported 2，913，136 tons of coal in September；this renresented a 40.6 per cent increase over the tonnage imported，a year ago．The September，1936－ 1940 imports averaged $1,673,728$ tons．

Exports of Canadian coal in September rose to 44,883 tons from the Sojtember， 1940 total of 42,290 tons and the five－year average for the month of 36，22？tons

Canada＇s coal supply in September（computed on the basis of production plus impotts less exports）totalled 4，446，125 tons compared with 3，396，020 tons made available，a year ago

## COKE - SEPPPMBER - 1941

Production of coke in Canada from imported and Canadian coal amounted to 262,942 tons in September compared with 266,421 tons in the previous month and 252,301 tons in September, 1940.

During the month under review 129,830 tons of Canadian coal and 239,7:7 tons of imported coal were carbonized in Canada to make a total oven charge for the first nine months of this year of $1,088,178$ tons of Canadion coal and 2,125,741 tons of of imported coal. Coke made from these charges totalled 2,322,980 tons compared with 2,227,028 tons made during the first nine months of a year ago.

Stocks of coke in the hands of the producers on September 30, 1941, amounted to 290,183 tons distributed across Canada as follows: 48,606 tons in the East, 207,136 tons in Ontario and 34,441 tons in the West.
