

## MONTHLY REPORT

## 

Canadian production of coal during the month of Feb ran amounted to $1,465,697$ tons, a decline of 9.5 per cent from the Januery figure of $1,620,669$ tons and 7 per cent from the Fecmary, 1943 output of $1,578,854$ tons. Production for the first two months of the present year totalled $3,086,366$ tons compere with $3,138,168$ tons for the corresponding period of 19,4 .

Production in Nova Scotia for the month amounted to 513,987 tons making a total of $1,058,394$ tons for the first two months of the year. This was slightly below the February, 1943 figure of 532,893 tons and $1,065,273$ tons for the two months period of inst year.

Newt Brunswick produced 26,680 tons during the month with a total of 53,847 tons for the year to date compered with 31,017 tons in: February, 1943 and 62,044 tons for the corresponding two months period.

Output from Saskatchewan mines for the month came to 233,768 tons compered with 142,903 tons in February, 1943. The total tonnage produced for Jenuery and Fobruary of this year amounted to 279,614 tons as compered with 309,436 tons for the similar period of 1943.

Alberta's production for the month was reported at 594,792 tons, a decrease of 15 per cent from the February, 1943 production of 701,663 tons. For the first two months of the present year the output totalled $1,313,445$ tons compared with 1,373,104 tons for the corresponding period of $19 / 43$.

Production in British Columbia during the month amounted to 196,470 tons, an increase of 15 per cent over the February, 19/4 output of 170,188 tons. For the first two months of the year the outplat totalled. 381,066 tons as against 327,840 tons for the same period of 1943.

Imports of coal into Canada during February amounted to $1,129,40 \%$ tons compared with 903,845 tons imported in February, 1943. Imports for the year to date totalled 2,311,00\% tons compered with $1,760,787$ tons for the sane period of 1943.

Coal exported during the month under review amounted to 97,812 tons making a total of 172,529 tons for the two months ending February 29th. During February, 1943 the exports amounted to 75,149 tons, with 110,279 tons for the corresponding two months period.

Fmpolyees in the coal nines of Canada for tire month of February numbered 27,689 compared :isth 25,571 for the same month of 1943 .

## COKR - FEBRIARY $=1944$

Production of coke from ovens and gas retorts in Ganada for February totalled 331,508 tons, an average of 11,431 tons a day, compared with 11,142 tons a day in January, when the total tonnage was 345,392. In January of 1943 the total was 232,036 tons, an average of 7,485 tons a day.

During February, 104,934 tons of Canadian coal and 342,627 tons of imported coal were charged to coke ovems to make a total charge of 447,521 tons.

Stociss of zoke (made from coal) in the hands of prodncers on February 29, 1944, amounted to 229,352 tons, of wich 43,952 toas were located in the east, 168,258 tons in Onturio awd 17,142 tons in the westo

Canadian oil refineries produced 5,614 tans of petroleun ooke during February, 245 tons of which were used in tine plants. Domestic seles amounted to 520 tons, saies to dealers 2,899 ton3, and 1,445 tons were sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 4,109 tons, and leaving 1,862 tons on hand on Febxuary 29, 1944.
