MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA, MARCH, 1944.

The output of coal from Canadian mines during the month of March amounted to 1,549,092 tons, a decrease of 8.2 per cent from the March, 1943 production of 1,688,463 tons. Production for the year to date was 4,635,458 tons compared with 4,826,631 tons for the same period of 1943.

During the month, Nova Scotia produced 579,678 tons making a total of 1,638,072 tons for the year to date, compared with 603,862 tons for March, 1943 and 1,669,135 tons for the first three months of 1943.

New Brunswick produced 30,450 tons during the month, compared with 29,633 tons in March, 1943. The total production for the year to date was 84,297 tons compared with 91,677 tons for the same period of last year.

Saskatchewan mines had an output of 148,639 tons for the month, with 428,253 tons being produced for the first three months of the year. Comparative figures for the corresponding periods of 1943 were 113,202 tons and 422,688 tons.

Production for the month in Alberta amounted to 579,159 tons compared with 752,083 tons in March 1943. Production for the year to date was 1,892,604 tons compared with 2,125,187 tons for the first quarter of 1943.

British Columbia's output for the month was 211,166 tons and for the year to date 592,232 tons compared with 189,535 tons and 517,375 tons for the corresponding periods of 1943.

Of the total Dominion production for the month, Nova Scotia contributed 37%, Alberta 37%, British Columbia 14%, Saskatchewan 10%, and New Brunswick 2%.

Imports of coal into Canada during March amounted to 1,382,819 tons compared with 1,285,189 tons imported in March 1943. Imports for the year to date totalled 3,693,823 tons compared with 3,045,976 tons for the same period of 1943.

Coal exported during the month of March amounted to 79,413 tons making a total of 251,942 tons for the year to date. During March, 1943 the exports amounted to 79,732 tons with a total of 190,011 tons for the year to date.

The number of employees in the coal mines of Canada during the month of February totalled 27,007 compared with 25,541 for the same month of 1943.

COKE - MARCH - 1944

Production of coke from ovens and gas retorts in Canada for March totalled 355,708 tons, an average of 11,474 tons a day, compared with 11,431 tons a day in February when the total tonnage was 331,508. In Merch of 1943 the total was 275,838 tons, an average of 8,898 tons a day.

During March, 116,142 tons of Canadian coal and 360,238 tons of imported coal were charged to coke ovens to make a total charge of 476,380 tons.

Stocks of coke (made from ccal) in the hands of producers on March 31st, 1944, amounted to 255,849 tons, of which 45,254 tons were located in the east, 191,325 tons in Ontario and 19,270 tons in the west.

Canadian oil refineries produced 7,062 tons of petroleum coke during March, 23 tons of which were used in the plants. Domestic sales amounted to 914 tons, sales to dealers 1,050 tons, and 771 tons were sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 2,758 tons, and leaving 6,166 tons on hand on March 31st, 1944.
