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MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA, APRIL, 1945

Coal production in Canada during April amounted to 1,316,129 tons, making a total for the year to date of 5,977,089 tons compared with 1,236,200 tons in April, 1944 and 5,863,268 tons for the first four months of 1944.

Nova Scotia produced 452,539 tons during the month compared with 482,975 tons in April 1944. Froduction for the year to date totalled 1,908,954 tons compared with 2,120,037 tons for the corresponding period of last year.

New Brunswick produced 27,992 tons during the month compared with 23,587 tons in April, 1944. Production for the year to date totalled 126,642 tons compared with 105,579 tons for the same period of 1944.

Saskatchewan produced 91,235 tons during the month making a total of 556,968 tons for the year to date compared with 69,628 tons in April, 1944 and 490,414 tons in the first four months of 1944.

Output from Alberta mines during the month amounted to 591,880 tons and included 407,980 tons of bituminous coal and 183,900 tons of sub-bituminous coal. This month's production was 19 per cent higher than the April 1944 production of 496,681 tons. Production for the year to date totalled 2,734,655 tons compared with 2,385,174 tons produced in the same period of 1944.

British Columbia produced 152,483 tons during the month compared with 163,279 tons in April, 1944. Production for the year to date totalled 649,870 tons compared with 762,064 tons for the corresponding period of 1944.

Alberta contributed 45 per cent of the Dominion production for the month, Nova Scotia 34 per cent, British Columbia 12 per cent, Saskatchewan 7 per cent and New Brunswick 2 per cent.

Canada imported 1,315,837 tons during April making a total of 3,831,504 tons for the year to date compared with 1,700,695 tons imported during April, 1944 and 5,394,518 tons for the first four months of 1944.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 80,026 tons compared with 56,582 tons in April, 1944. Total exports for the year to date amounted to 306,933 tons compared with 308,524 tons for the same period of 1944.

Employees in the coal mines of Canada numbered 25,066 in March compared with 26,204 in March 1944.

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COKE - APRIL, 1945

Output of coke from ovens and gas retorts in Canada during the month of April amounted to 325,617 tons compared with 341,793 tons in the previous month and 337,937 tons in April, 1944. Production for the month was made up of 89,488 tons from the eastern provinces, 866,310 tons from Ontario and 96,788 tons from Western Canada.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 100,301 tons of Canadian coal and 337,646 tons of imported coal.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on April 30, 1945 amounted to 82,221 tons of which 24,794 tons were located in the eastern provinces. 45,933 tons in Ontario and 11,494 tons in western provinces. Stocks of breeze totalled 176,107 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 13,277 tons in the eastern provinces, 147,737 tons in Ontario and 15,093 tons in the western provinces.

Canadian oil refineries produced 5,244 tons of petroleum coke during April, 696 tons of which were used in the plants, 580 tons sold for domestic use and 437 tons sold to dealers for resale, 4,503 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 6,206 tons and leaving 7,389 tons on hand at April 30.
