MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA, JUNE, 1945

Coal production in Canada during the month of June amounted to 1,270,985 tons, making a total for the first six months of the year of 8,419,671 tons compared with 1,233,251 tons in June, 1944 and 8,387,286 tons for the first six months of 1944. Production for the month included 1,033,086 tons of bituminous coal, 193,232 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 44,667 tons of lignite coal.

Nova Scotia produced 433,387 tons during the month making a total of 2,748,845 tons of the year to date compared with 463,403 tons in June, 1944 and 3,045,139 tons for the first six months of 1944.

New Brunswick's output for the month amounted to 31,989 tons compared with 25,944 tons in June, 1944. Output for the year to date totalled 187,617 tons compared with 155,492 tons for the same period of 1944.

Saskatchewan mines produced 44,667 tons during June compared with 41,798 tons in June 1944. Production for the first six months of the year totalled 680,640 tons, an increase of 14 per cent over the total of 595,790 tons for the corresponding period of 1944.

Production in Alberta during the month amounted to 614,196 tons and included 420,964 tons of bituminous coal and 193,232 tons of sub-bituminous coal, making a total for the year to date of 3,865,835 tons. In June of the previous year Alberta's production amounted to 512,757 tons with a total of 3,453,050 tons for the first six months of 1944.

Production in British Columbia amounted to 146,746 tons for the month and for the year to date 936,734 tons compared with 189,349 tons in June, 1944 and 1,137,815 tons for the first six months of 1944.

Canada imported 2,794,689 tons of coal during the month making a total of 9,081,952 tons for the year to date compared with 3,157,313 tons imported during June, 1944 and 11,534,806 tons for the first six months of 1944.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 70,568 tons compared with 90,286 tons in June, 1944. Total exports for the year to date amounted to 445,737 tons compared with 522,736 tons for the same period of 1944.

Employees in the coal mines of Canada numbered 24,059 in May compared with 24,343 in May, 1944.

COKE - JUNE, 1945

Output of coke from ovens and gas retorts in Canada during the month of June amounted to 323,784 tons compared with 333,090 tons in the previous month and 327,601 tons in June, 1944. Production for the month was made up of 89,891 tons from the eastern provinces, 212,086 tons from Ontario and 21,807 tons from Western Canada.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 104,630 tons of Canadian coal and 337,981 tons of imported coal.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on June 30th, 1945 amounted to 75,701 tons of which 23,375 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 42,780 tons in Ontario and 9,546 tons in western provinces. Stocks of breeze totalled 180,999 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 13,231 tons in the eastern provinces, 144,690 tons in Ontario and 23,078 tons in the western provinces.

Canadian oil refineries produced 6,359 tons of petroleum coke during June, 774 tons of which were used in the plants, 1,747 tons sold for domestic use and 101 tons sold to dealers for resale, 4,736 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 7,358 tons and leaving 4,831 tons on hand on June 30, 1945.
