#### MONTHLY REPORT

### COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA, JULY, 1945

Coal production in Canada during the month of July amounted to 1,077,871 tons and included 896,747 tons of bituminous coal, 136,080 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 45,044 tons of lignite coal. This month's production was 8 per cent lower than the July, 1944 production of 1,168,859 tons.

Nova Scotia produced 356,418 tons or 33 per cent of the total coal mined in Canada during the month and Alberta 514,019 tons or 48 per cent. British Columbia produced 130,240 tons; Saskatchewan 45,044 tons and New Brunswick 32,150 tons.

Canadian output of coal for the first seven months of the year totalled 9,547,995 tons compared with 9,555,919 tons for the corresponding period of last year. Nova Scotia's output for this period totalling 3,133,923 tons showed a decline of 9 per cent from the previous year; Alberta showed an increase of 10.5 per cent with 4,386,876 tons; Saskatchewan increased 13 per cent with 726,524 tons; New Brunswick increased 16 per cent with 222,639 tons and British Columbia's output of 1,078,033 tons for the seven months was 18 per cent below that of 1944.

Canada imported 2,996,281 tons of coal during the month making a total of 12,078,233 tons for the year to date, compared with 3,240,896 tons imported during July, 1944 and 14,775,702 tons for the first seven months of 1944.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 51,953 tons compared with 100,084 tons in July, 1944. Total exports for the year to date amounted to 497,690 tons compared with 622,820 tons for the same period of 1944.

Employees in the coal mines of Canada during the month of July numbered 23,850 compared with 23,618 in July, 1944.

#### COKE - JULY, 1945

Output of coke from ovens and gas retorts in Canada during the month of July amounted to 329,539 tons compared with 323,784 tons in the previous month and 321,732 tons in July, 1944. Production for the month was made up of 91,042 tons from the eastern provinces, 216,886 tons from Ontario and 21,611 tons from Western Canada.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 102,128 tons of Canadian coal and 346,462 tons of imported coal.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on July 31st, 1945 amounted to 78,664 tons, of which 23,935 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 44,251 tons in Ontario and 10,478 tons in western provinces. Stocks of breeze totalled 184,340 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 12,864 tons in the eastern provinces, 146,811 tons in Ontario and 24,665 tons in the western provinces.

Canadian oil refineries produced 6,951 tons of petroleum coke during July, 600 tons of which were used in the plants, 1,707 tons sold for domestic use and 242 tons sold to dealers for resale, 4,025 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 6,574 tons and leaving 5,208 tons on hand on July 31st, 1945.
