#### MONTHLY REPORT

### COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA, AUGUST, 1945

Coal production in Canada during the month of August amounted to 1,202,560 tons and included 884,678 tons of bituminous coal, 264,030 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 53,852 tons of lignite coal. Production for the month was 13 per cent lower than the August, 1944 production of 1,379,044 tons.

Alberta produced 673 992 tons or 56 per cent of the coal mined in Canada during August and Nova Scotia produced 310,221 tons or 26 per cent. Production in British Columbia amounted to 134,170 tons, in Saskatchewan 53.852 tons and in New Brunswick 30 325 tons.

Canadian output of coal for the first eight months of the year totalled 10,750.555 tons compared with 10,934,963 tons for the corresponding period of last year. Nova Scotia's output for this period totalling 3,444,144 tons showed a decline of 12 per cent from the previous year; Alberta showed an increase of 10 per cent with 5,060,868 tons; Saskatchewan increased 10 per cent with 780,376 tons and British Columbia's output of 1,212,203 tons for the eight months was 21 per cent below that of 1944.

Canada imported 2,799,328 tons of coal during August making a total of 14,877,561 tons for the year to date, compared with 3,506,156 tons imported during August, 1944 and 18,281,858 tons for the first eight months of 1944.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 59,340 tons compared with 79,131 tons in August, 1944. Total exports for the year to date amounted to 557,030 tons compared with 701,951 tons for the same period of 1944.

Employees in the coal mines of Canada during the month of August numbered 23,801 compared with 23,700 in August, 1944.

# EMPLOYMENT IN CANADIAN COAL MINES, BY PROVINCES, 1944 AND 1945

#### COKE - AUGUST, 1945.

Output of coke from ovens and gas retorts in Canada during the month of August amounted to 329,216 tons compared with 329,539 tons in the previous month and 327,916 tons in August, 1944. Production for the month was made up of 90,727 tons from the eastern provinces, 217,382 tons from Ontario and 21,107 tons from Western Canada.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 100,140 tons of Canadian coal and 346,543 tons of imported coal.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on August 31st, 1945 amounted to 85,913 tons, of which 22,984 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 52,364 tons in Ontario and 10,565 tons in western provinces. Stocks of breeze totalled 189,245 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 12,963 tons in the eastern provinces, 150,068 tons in Ontario and 26,214 tons in the western provinces.

Canadian oil refineries produced 8,160 tons of petroleum coke during August, 413 tons of which were used in the plants, 1,068 tons sold for domestic use and 386 tons sold to dealers for resale, 4,461 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 6,328 tons and leaving 7,040 tons on hand on August 31st, 1945.
