MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA, SEPTEMBER, 1945

Canadian coal production during the month of September amounted to 1,178,016 tons, a decline of 15 per cent from the September 1944 output of 1,391,475 tons. Output of bituminous coal during the month totalled 864,554 tons, sub-bituminous coal 207,963 tons and lignite coal 105,499 tons.

Of the total September output, Alberta produced 556,907 tons, Nova Scotia 371,592 tons, British Columbia 117,713 tons, Saskatchewan 105,499 tons and New Brunswick 26,305 tons.

Production for the first mine months of the year totalled 11,928,571 tons, a decline of 5 per cent from the 12,326,438 tons produced in the corresponding period of 1944. Production for the first mine months of the year, by provinces, was as follows: Alberta 5,617,775 tons; Nova Scotia 3,815,736 tons; British Columbia 1,329,916 tons; Saskatchewan 885,875 tons; New Brunswick 279,269 tons.

Imports of coal into Canada during September amounted to 2,815,695 tons compared with 3,592,837 tons in September,1944. Imports for the year to date totalled 17,693,256 tons compared with 21,674,695 tons in the corresponding period of 1944.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 78,507 tons compared with 96,759 tons in September, 1944. Total exports for the year to date amounted to 635,537 tons compared with 798,710 tons for the same period of 1944.

Employees in the coal mines of Canada during the month of September numbered 23,930 compared with 24,422 in September 1944.

COKE - SEPTEMBER - 1945

Output of coke from ovens and gas retorts in Canada during the month of September amounted to 518,149 tons compared with 329,216 tons in the previous month and 320,680 tons in September 1944. Production for the month was made up of 84,584 tons from the eastern provinces, £13,302 tons from Ontario and 20,263 tons from Western Canada.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 91,970 tons of Canadian coal and 333,639 tons of imported coal.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on September 30, 1945 amounted to 81,827 tons, of which 18,445 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 52,668 tons in Ontario and 10,714 tons in the western provinces. Stocks of breeze totalled 186,825 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 13,183 tons in the eastern provinces, 146,474 tons in Ontario and 27,168 tons in the western provinces.

Canadian oil refineries produced 4,774 tons of petroleum coke during September, 368 tons of which were used in the plants; 1,074 tons sold for domestic use; 93 tons sold to dealers for resale, and 4,214 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 5,749 tons and leaving 6,065 tons on hand on September 30, 1945.
