## MONTHLX REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISIICS FOR CANADA, OCTOBER, 1946

Production of coal in Canada during the month of October amounted to $1,624,591$ tons, makiag a total of $14,601,416$ tons for the year to date. Production for the moath included $1,131,027$ tons of bituminous coal, 308,605 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 184,959 tons of lignite coal. Compared with last year, production showed an increase of 33 per cent in October and for the first ten months of the yoar an increase of 11 per cent.

The large increase in production for the month compared with last year was owing to the October, 1945, output being greatly reduced as a result of atrikes in Alberta and British Columbia.

Alberta produced 763,682 tons during the month under review, an increase of 73 per cent over the output in October, 1945; Nove Scotie produced 500,204 tons, an increase of 12 per cent; Saskatchewan 184,959 tons, a decrease of 16 per cent; British Columbia 134,667 tons, an increase of 68 per cent and New Brungwack 41,079 tons, an increase of 31 per cent.

Imports of cosl into Caneda during October amounted to $4,069,680$ tons, compared with 2,661,949 tons imported during October, 1945. Imports for the first ten months of the year totalled $21,880,140$ tons compered with $20,355,205$ tons in the correspondiag period of last year.

Ccal exported during the month mounted to 85,428 tons compared with 74,778 tons 10 Uctober, 1945. Exports for the first ten months of the fear totelled 684,616 tons compared with 710,315 tons in the same period of 1945.

Baployees in the coal mines of Canada during the month of October numbered 25,330 compared with 24,457 in October, 1945.

## COKS - OCTOBKR, 1946

Production of coke from ovens and gas retorts durine the month of October smounted to 271,351 tons compared with 194,593 tons produced in the previous month and 309,963 tong in Ootober, 1945. Tomage produced during the month was made up of 74,889 tons from the eastern profinces, 173,282 tons from Onterio and 23,180 tons from Western Canade.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 95,165 tons of Canedian coal and 271,655 tons of imported coal.

Produoars' stoaks of oven and retort coke, axcluding breeze, on October 31, 1946, emomnted to 195,234 tons, of which 35,292 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 155,855 tons in Ontario and 4,087 tons in the western provinces. Stocks of breaze totalled 187,799 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 17,484 tona in the easterm provinces, 149,877 tons in Ontario, and 20,438 tons in the western provinces.

Cunadan oil refinerien produced 6,063 tons of petroleum coke during October, 230 tons of wich were used in the plants, 1,402 tuns soid for domestic use, 88 tons sold to dealers for resale, and 6,677 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 8,404 tons and leaving 8,060 tons on hand on October 3let, 1946.
