## MONTHLY REPORT

## COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1946

Production of coal in Canada during the month of November amounted to 1,576,999 tons and included 1,018,691 tons of bituminous coal, 362,385 tons of sub-bituminous coal and 195,923 tons of lignite coal. Production was 3 per cent lower than the previous month and 12 per cent below the output of November, 1945. Total production for the first eleven months of the year amounted to 16,225,391 tons, an increase of 8 per cent over the tonnage produced in the corresponding period of 1945.

Nova Scotia produced 496,204 tons during the month making a total of 5,003,121 tons for the first eleven months of the year. Production showed an increase of 2 per cent for November and 5 per cent for the eleven months compared with the production in the same periods of 1945.

Alberta's production for November amounting to 729,302 tons showed a decline of 19 per cent compared with November, 1945, but production for the first eleven months of the year increased 15 per cent over the output in the same period of last year and totalled 8.062.154 tons.

Saskatchewan produced 195,923 tons during the month, a decrease of 13 per cent from the output of November, 1945; British Columbia's production, amounting to 118,180 tons, declined 21 per cent, and New Brunswick showed an increase of 17 per cent with 37,390 tons.

Imports of coal into Canada during November amounted to 3,465,368 tons and for the first eleven months of the year totalled 25,345,508 tons. The total quantity imported for the first eleven months was 12 per cent higher than for the corresponding period of 1945.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 74,588 tons compared with 70,374 tons in November, 1945. Exports for the first eleven months of the year totalled 759,204 tons compared with 780,689 tons in the same period of 1945.

Employees in the coal mines of Canada during the month of November numbered 26,303 compared with 25,969 in November, 1945.

## COKE - NOVEMBER, 1946

Production of coke from ovens and gas retorts during the month of November amounted to 320,183 tons compared with 271,351 tons produced in the previous month and 284,204 tons in November, 1945. Tonnage produced during the month was made up of 87,349 tons from the eastern provinces, 210,648 tons from Ontario and 22,186 tons from Western Canada.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 104,280 tons of Canadian coal and 314,335 tons of imported coal.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on November 30, 1946, amounted to 195,528 tons, of which 31,985 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 159,401 tons in Ontario and 4,142 tons in the western provinces. Stocks of breeze totalled 196,663 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 16,878 tons in the eastern provinces, 159,077 tons in Ontario, and 20,708 tons in the western provinces.

Canadian oil refineries produced 6,899 tons of petroleum coke during November, 327 tons of which were used in the plants, 884 tons sold for domestic use, 205 tons sold to dealers for resale, and 4,148 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 5,564 tons and leaving 8,633 tons on hand on November 30, 1946.
