MONTHLY REPORT

COAL AND COKE STATISTICS FOR CANADA, DECEMBER, 1946

Production of coal in Canada during the month of December amounted to 1,572,356 tons, making a total of 17,797,478 tons for the twelve months of 1946. Production showed an increase of 1 per cent in December and 8 per cent for the twelve months of the year compared with the tonnages produced in the corresponding periods of 1945.

Nove Scotia produced 450,261 tons during the month making a total of 5,452,316 tons for the year. Compared with the previous year production increased 23 per cent in December and 7 per cent for the twelve months.

Production in Alberta declined 8 per cent in December compared with the previous year but output for the twelve months of 1946 showed an increase of 13 per cent. Production in December totalled 758,453 tons and for the year 8,820,849 tons.

Saskatchewan produced 207,622 tons in December, making a total for the year of 1,522,207 tons, compared with 203,477 tons and 1,532,995 tons produced in the corresponding periods of 1945.

Production in British Columbia showed a decline of 10 per cent for December and 4 per cent for the twelve months compared with the previous year.

New Brunswick produced 29,580 tons in December compared with 21,589 tons in December, 1945 and 366,735 tons for the year compared with 361,184 tons in 1945.

Imports of coal into Canada during December amounted to 1,477,345 tons and for the twelve months of 1946 totalled 26,822,853 tons. Compared with 1945, imports declined 30 per cent in December but showed an increase of 8 per cent for the twelve months of 1946.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 103,285 tons compared with 60,019 tons in December, 1945. Exports for the year totalled 862,489 tons compared with 840,708 tons in 1945.

Employees in the coal mines of Canada during the month of December numbered 26,211 compared with 26,251 in December, 1945.

COKE - DECEMBER, 1946

Production of coke from ovens and gas retorts during the month of December amounted to 320,514 tons compared with 320,183 tons produced in the previous month and 312,021 tons in December, 1945. Tonnage produced during the month was made up of 86,602 tons from the eastern provinces, 208,342 tons from Ontario and 25,570 tons from Western Canada.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 110,229 tons of Canadian coal and 324,456 tons of imported coal.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on December 31, 1946, amounted to 175,634 tons, of which 27,740 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 143,237 tons in Ontario and 4,657 tons in the western provinces. Stocks of breeze totalled 192,370 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 15,116 tons in the eastern provinces, 157,919 tons in Ontario and 19,335 tons in the western provinces.

Canadian oil refineries produced 6,899 tons of petroleum coke during December, 327 tons of which were used in the plants, 884 tons sold for domestic use, 205 tons sold to dealers for resale, and 4,148 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 5,564 tons and leaving 8,633 tons on hand on December 31, 1946.
