

## MONTHLY HEPORT

## COAL AND COKE STATT STICS FOK CANADA, MARCH, 1946

Output from coal mines in Canada during March totelled 1,593, 556 tons, comprising 1, 200,571 tona of bituminous coal, 272,206 tons of sub-bitiminous coal and 120,979 tons of lignite coal, making a total of $5,048,529$ tons for the year to date. Compared with March of the prevous year, the month's production showed an increase of 8.4 per cent and an increase of 8.2 per cant for the first three months of the year.

Miberta produced 765,838 tons or 48 per cent of the March output; Nova Scotia 514,585 tons or 32 per cant; British Columbia 165,749 tons or 10 per cent; Saskatcheman 120,979 tons or 8 per cent, end Now Brunswick 26,405 tons or 2 par cent.

Imports of coal into Cenada during Merch amounted to $1,452,876$ tons compared with 934,677 tons in March, 1945. Imports for the first three months of the jear totelled 3,960,500 tons compered with 2,515,667 tons in the corresponding period of 1945.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 63,080 tons compared with 79,138 tons in March, 1945. Total exports for the first three months of the year amounted to 151,699 tons compared with 226,907 tons for the seme period of 1945 .

Bmployees in the coal mines of Canada during the month of March numbered 25,765 compared with 25,026 in March, 1945.

## COKB - MARCH - 1946

Production of coke from ovens and gas rotorts during the month of March amounted to 338, 285 tons compared wh th 298,899 tons produced in the provious montin and 341,793 tons in March, 1945. Tonnage produced during the month was made up of 95,285 tons from the astern provinces, 220,046 tons from Ontario and 24,954 tons from lestarn Canade.

Charges to ovens or retorta during the month included 113,260 tons of Canadian coal ard 338,65 ? tons of imported coal.

Stocire of coke (asde from coal) In the hands of producers on March 52, 1946 amounted to 230,581 tons, of which 14,250 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 186,749 tons in Ontario sad 29,602 tons in the westarn provinces.

Canadian ofl reftineries produced 5,143 tons of petroleum coke during March, 437 tons of which wore used in plants, 465 tons ware sold for domestic use, 293 tons sold to dealars, and 599 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of 1,794 tons and leaving 10,960 tons on hand on Marciz $31,1946$.
