## COAL AND COKE STATISTICS POR CANADA, MARCH, 1947.

Production of coal in Canade was greatly reduced during March as a result of the strike in the coal mines of Nova Scotia and New Brunswick. Total production for the month amounting to 969,934 tons was 39 per cent below the output of March, 1946. Production for the first three months of the year totalled $3,779,058$ tons, a drop of 25 per cent compared with the corresponding period of last year.

Production decreased 12 per cent in Alberta compared with March, 1946, and in British Columbia 15 per cent. In Saskatchewan production was 29 per cent higer than in March, 1946.

Imports of coal into Canada during Warch decilned 13 per cent compared With March, 194. During the month $1,263,888$ tons were imported, making e. total of 3,731,659 tons for the first three months of the year compared with $1,452,876$ tons imported in March, 1946, and 3,960,500 tons during the f1rst three months of 1946.

Coal exported during the month amounted to 37,533 tons compered with 63,080 tons in March, 1946.

The number of persons employed in coal mines in Conada during Karch was 13,723 compared whth 25,767 in March, 1946.

## COKE - MARCH, 1947

Production of coke from ovens and gas retorts during the month of March amounted to 308,071 tons compered with 289,193 tons produced $1 n$ the previous month and 338,285 tons in March, 1946. Tonnage produced during the month was made up of 73,944 tons from the eastern provinces, 209,061 tons from Ontario and 25,066 tons from western canada.

Charges to ofens or retorts during the month. included 90,849 tons of canadian coal and 319,798 tons of 1 mported coel.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on March 3lst, 1947, amounted to 126,240 tons, of which 8,687 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 114,649 tons in Onterlo and 2,904 tons in the western movinces. Stocks of breeze totelled 209,299 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 8,077 tons in the eastern provinces, 183, 877 tons in Ontario and 17,345 tons in the stern provinces.

Canadian oil refineries produced 7,490 tons of petroleum coke during harch, 163 tons of wich were used in the plants, 1,040 tons sold for domestic use, 106 tons sold to dealers for resale, and 5,885 tons sold for other purposes, making a total disposition of $\dot{7}, 194$ tons, and leaving 11,589 tons on hand on March 31st, 1947.
