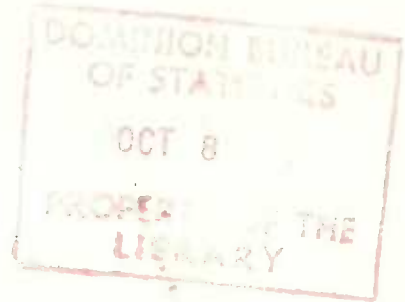

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COAL AND COKE STATISTICS

(a) Coal - Production, Imports, Exports

Production of coal during the month of July amounted to 836,037 tons, an increase of 6.5 per cent over the output in July, 1955.

Production of coal from stripping operations in July amounted to 226,107 tons, or 27.0 per cent of the total output. This was an increase of 23.7 per cent over the strip mine output in July, 1955.

Landed imports of coal during the month under review amounted to 2,500,914 tons, an increase of 39.0 per cent compared with landed imports in July, 1955. Exports of coal for the month amounted to 57,042 tons, compared with 34,906 tons in the corresponding month of last year.

(b) Coke - Production, Imports, Exports

Production of coke from ovens and gas reports during the month of July, 1956, amounted to 369,664 tons, as compared with 359,051 tons in the previous month and 340,288 tons in July, 1955. Tonnage produced during the month was made up of 80,150 tons from the eastern provinces, 262,506 tons from Ontario and 27,008 tons from western Canada.

Charges to ovens or retorts during the month included 97,321 tons of Canadian coal and 417,666 tons of imported coal.

Producers' stocks of oven and retort coke, excluding breeze, on July 31st, 1956, amounted to 153,370 tons, of which 17,631 tons were located in the eastern provinces, 94,260 tons in Ontario and 41,479 tons in the western provinces. Stocks of breeze totalled 54,926 tons and were located across Canada as follows: 10,947 tons in the eastern province, 35,008 tons in Ontario and 8,971 tons in the western provinces.
