OCTOBER, 1952

Total operating revenues of Canadian air Carriers for October were well above the similar month of 1951, advancing \$1,162,633 or 17.8 per cent to \$7,701,771 from \$6,539,138. Total operating expenses, however, rose more rapidly to \$7,489,664 from \$5,954,511, a gain of \$1,535,153 or 25.8 per cent. Company plans for expansion or a change over to the new and more advanced types of aircraft such as those with jet and turbo-prop power plants have tended to accelerate depreciation charges.

The net operating revenues during October, 1952 thus amounted to \$212,107, considerably below the \$584,627 earned during the corresponding period of 1951. The decline in net operating revenues was general throughout the industry. The domestic and trans-border services of the scheduled carriers reported a net of \$387.668 as compared to \$471,490 in the previous October and their international services operated at a deficit of \$80,200 as against a surplus of \$58,676 one year earlier. The non-scheduled carriers also reported a deficit of \$95,361 in the month under review versus a surplus of \$54,461.

Almost all the revenue and expense accounts were higher in October, 1952 than in the same period of the previous year. Passenger farss amounted to \$4,619,269, an advance of \$520,029 over the October, 1951 total of \$4,099,240. Revenue received for the carriage of goods rose to \$435,933 from \$338,705 and mail produced \$787,942 as compared to \$764,967 in the preceeding October.

Revenue from bulk transportation advanced 50 per cent to \$1,520,378 from \$1,013,070 in the corresponding period of 1951. The cost of air operation and maintenance rose nearly one million dollars to \$4,424,995 from \$3,429,901 while ground operation and maintenance expenses were up to \$1,891,071 from \$1,536,788, an increase of \$354,283 or 23.1 per cent.

Operating statistics of Canadian carriers show advances for the month of October similar to the revenue and expense accounts. The total number of revenue passengers carried in unit toll transportation improved to 148,014 from 130,580, a gain of 17,434 or 13,4 per cent while the number of revenue passenger miles increased to 69,729,380 from 57,522,203 miles or by 21,2 per cent. Revenue passengers carried in bulk transportation numbered 27,073 as compared to 19,523 in October, 1951.

The total weight of revenue goods carried by Canadian carriers in unit toll transportation amounted to 2,885,517 lbs. and showed an increase of 771,824 lbs. or 36.5 per cent over the same month of 1951. Revenue goods ton miles rose to 880,758 from 672,313 or by 31 per cent. Revenue goods carried in bulk transportation at 9,194,101 lbs. amounted to more than three times the total of the preceding October, namely 2,878,779 lbs. The total of all goods transported during the month thus reached 12,528,346 lbs. as compared to 5,333,915 lbs. reported for the previous October. Mail also shared in the general improvement rising to 1,262,319 from 1,179,393 lbs. which were carried 474,771 ton miles versus 440,833 one year earlier.

The increased activity as shown above resulted in more hours and miles flown. The number of hours logged on unit tell transportation reached a total of 19,002 and covered a distance of 3,315,034 miles as compared to 17,722 hours and 2,994,591 miles in October of 1951. An additional 13,466 hours and 1,684,096 miles were logged for bulk transportation against 10,470 hours and 1,165,603 miles, respectively.
