NOVEMBER, 1952

The month of November was a very active one for Canadian air carriers as new highs for the month were established for nearly all revenue and expense accounts and most of the operational items. Total operating revenues which rose to \$6,139,456 from \$5,581,473 in November, 1051, (a gain of \$557,983 or 10 per cent) were, however, exceeded by total expenses which advanced 19.9 per cent to \$6,965,963 from \$5,808,497. The anticipated seasonal deficit thus amounted to \$826,507, considerably above the operating loss of \$227,024 reported for November of the previous year.

Net operating revenues were in the red for all divisions throughout the industry. The domestic and trans-border services of the scheduled carriers reported a deficit of \$412,174 as compared with one amounting to \$108,082 in the previous November and their international services lost \$171,289 as against a profit of \$74,410. The non-scheduled carriers, which had a deficit of \$192,452 for November, 1951, reported a larger one amounting to \$243,044 in the month under review.

The individual accounts generally show improvement over the corresponding period of 1951. The revenue received for the transportation of passengers in unit toll transportation increased to \$3,642,418 from the November, 1951 high of \$3,425,576, a gain of \$146,842 or 4.2 per cent. Mail revenue advanced slightly to 1781,359 from \$776,394 and the carriage of goods provided \$399,465 as compared with \$361,508 in the preceding November. An additional 335,369 charged for excess baggage brought the total revenue received for unit toll transportation to \$4,858,611, an increase of \$185,763 or 4 per cent over the November 1951 total of \$4,672,848. Bulk transportation revenues also advanced from \$710,079 to \$850,256 or by 25.4 per cent. Expenses were all up appreciably. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs rose to \$3,956,571 from the November, 1951 total of \$3,246,196, a \$710,375 or 21.9 per cent increase and ground operation and maintenance cost \$1,832,070 as compared with \$1,579,154. The traffic and administration accounts were also higher than in the previous November.

Canadian sir carriers reported good progress from the viewpoint of operational data for the month of November. During the thirty day period a total of 138,067 passenge, where given sirlift as opposed to 118,226 in the similar period of 1951. Of the month's total, 118,463 were carried in unit toll transportation and 14,914 in bulk transportation compared with 103,914 and 10,075, respectively during the previous November. Revenue unit toll transportation passengers were flown 56,820,486 passenger miles versus 49,731,401.

The amount of revenue goods carried in unit toll transportation during the month aggregated 2,494,953 lbs. and was flown a distance of 838,943 ton miles, an advance of 443,135 lbs. or 21.6 per cent over the November, 1951 total of 2,051,818 lbs. which were transported 650,338 ton miles. Garroes carried in bulk transportation source to 8,220,206 lbs., more than five times the 1,530,947 lbs. reported in the same month of 1951; but resenues indicate that ton miles did not advance to the same degree.

Although the total weight of mirmail eased slightly to 1,197,064 lbs. from 1,287,261, mail ton miles increased to 473,669 from 464,413.

This increased activity is also reflected in other data. During the month, Canadian air carriers flew a total of 3,788,759 revenue miles, remaining aloft for 23,747 hours. Comparative figures for November, 1951 were 3,406,476 miles which required a flying time of 22,108 hours. Revenue unit toll transportation took 16,110 hours to fly 2,792,747 miles as against 15,858 hours for 2,677,820 miles in November, 1951 and bulk transportation logged 996,012 miles in 7,637 hours as compared with 728,656 miles and 6,250 hours in November, 1951.

Employment data show that 9,541 employees earned \$3,030,778 for their services during November compared with 8,033 receiving \$2,602,562 in the same period of 1951.

A summary of financial reports for the first eleven months of 1952 indicated a net income after income tax of \$2,841,563, which assures that the air carriers as a group produced a profit for the year.
