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CIVIL AVIATION

December, 1952

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Canadian air carriers reported gross operating revenues of 6,766,041 for the month of December, a new high for the month and \$1,031,481 or 18 per cent above the December, 1951 total of \$5,734,560. Operating expenses, however, increased from \$6,328,370 to \$7,591,230, a gain of 20 per cent which resulted in a higher net operating loss of \$825,189 as compared to the deficit of \$593,810 reported in the previous December. This decline in net operating revenues was practically all confined to the domestic and trans-border services of the scheduled carriers, which showed an operating loss of \$532,213 - more than twice the loss of \$228,059 reported in December, 1951. The international services of the scheduled carriers earned \$154,519 as compared to a surplus of \$81,661 a year earlier while the non-scheduled carriers had about the same deficit as in the previous December, \$447,495 against \$447,412.

All revenue and expense accounts for the month registered gains over the similar period of 1951. Passenger fares rose to \$3,921,031 from \$3,536,116 for a gain of 10.9 per cent. Mail was up to \$917,574 from \$854,017 and revenue goods advanced more rapidly to \$558,330 from \$416,271, an improvement of \$142,059 or 34.1 per cent. Excess baggage was, also, higher for the month at \$34,811 as compared to \$23,871 in the previous December. In addition, Canadian carriers earned \$1,043,156 through bulk transportation services as against \$686,833 in December, 1951, an increase of 51.9 per cent. Aircraft operation and maintenance charges rose from \$3,390,657 to \$4,203,775 with increased mileage while ground operation and maintenance expenses were up to \$1,986,550 from \$1,731,119. Traffic and administration expenses were also heavier.

During the month under review, Canadian aircraft flew a total of 3,055,239 miles in revenue unit toll transportation remaining aloft a total of 17,902 hours. This compares with 2,681,987 miles flown during 15,838 hours in the corresponding period of 1951. In addition, Canadian carriers logged 1,075,595 miles in 8,329 hours in bulk transportation, considerably above the December, 1951 total of 711,240 miles in 7,729 hours. Percentagewise, the increases were 51.2 and 7.8 per cent, respectively.

The total number of passengers carried by all Canadian carriers amounted to 147,473 of which 125,794 were carried in revenue unit toll transportation and 17,141 in bulk transportation. In December, 1951, the comparable total was 119,087 of which 104,883 were revenue unit toll passengers, and 10,664 bulk (charter or contract) passengers. Passenger miles performed in revenue unit toll transportation alone aggregated 59,694,226, an increase of 21.5 per cent over the previous December total of 49,119,565 miles.

The total weight of goods carried in revenue unit toll transportation amount to 3,600,117 lbs. up 1,068,774 lbs. on 42.2 per cent over the preceding December while goods ton-miles advanced from 716,892 to 903,883 ton-miles or by 26.1 per cent, indicating a shorter average flight. The weight of goods transported in bulk transportation advanced much more sharply to 6,117,731 lbs. from 1,269,231. Although the amount of mail carried rose from 1,516,263 lbs. to 1,730,801 or by 14.1 per cent, mail ton-miles were down to 646,530 from 722,247 ton-miles.

Gasoline and cil consumption and costs were up considerably over December, 1951. A total of 2,935,141 gals. of gasoline which cost \$943,704 were used against 2,495,817 gals. costing \$773,299 a year earlier. Employment continued active with 9,455 employees against 8,125 in the previous December, an increase of 1,330 or 16.4 per cent and the total salary and wage bill rose to \$3,068,070 from \$2,619,012.
